

Chelsea clinches English Premier League with win over West Brom

WEST BROMWICH, England
Chelsea clinched the English Premier League at the first opportunity on Friday, beating West Bromwich Albion 1-0 through Michy

Batshuayi's 82nd-minute goal to take an unassailable 10-point lead.
Chelsea manager Antonio Conte jumped into the arms of his fellow coaches near the dugout after Batshuayi — just on as a substitute — poked home a close-range finish from Cesar Azpilicueta's cut-back.

It is a second top-flight league title in three seasons and sixth in total for Chelsea, which has led the standings since early November.
Conte became the fourth manager to win the Premier League in his first season in English soccer. The Italian has had the golden touch, and it

extended to the title-clinching game.
Chelsea was being frustrated by a stubborn West Brom defending deep and in numbers, so Conte decided to take off Eden Hazard and Pedro Rodriguez and bring on Batshuayi — surprisingly — and Willian.

TRAIL CLOSURE IN POLICE POINT PARK DURING CONSTRUCTION OF NEW CRESCENT HEIGHTS LIFT STATION AND FORCEMAIN.

The Crescent Heights Lift Station project starting this spring involves the decommissioning and demolition of the existing lift station constructed in 1961, and construction of a new, replacement lift station to serve residents. For this work to be completed, a portion of trail along the north bank of the South Saskatchewan River will be closed until next spring. This closure is effective immediately to allow work to begin this week.

The Crescent Heights Lift Station is one of three major lift stations being upgraded by the City. The new lift stations are being constructed at higher elevation and will use submersible pumps and other flood-proofing measures to ensure it remains operational during potential future flood events. A new pipeline will also be installed from the new lift station to Police Point Park to support future development

Signs have been posted along the trail to provide notice to frequent users. In addition, there is a display in the Police Point Park Interpretive Centre describing this important infrastructure project. The portion of the trail that is closed will be an active construction site. It will be used by construction vehicles and traffic and will contain open excavations and other hazards. It is therefore important that residents obey all trail closure and construct signs for their safety.

All residents and businesses directly affected by construction are being notified directly and any interruptions to water and sanitary services will be coordinated with residents. During construction there will be occasional noise and vibration which will be minimized as much as possible.

Thank you to everyone for your understanding and patience as this work is carried out for the coming year.

FIRE HYDRANT & WATER MAIN FLUSHING

Environmental Utilities performs regular, routine maintenance to uphold the water quality and system infrastructure by annually testing and flushing fire hydrants and water mains.

In some areas of the City during these flushing operations, there may be some discoloration in the water which is not harmful to consume and will disappear when flushing is complete. Please note that discolored water should not be used for laundry and fluctuating water pressure may also be noticed.

Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, turn on your cold water tap and let the water run for 5-20 minutes or until the water runs clear.

The Environmental Utilities Solid Waste Department has finished yard waste compost, SureGrow, for sale while quantities last.

SureGrow is a Class 'A' soil amendment that greatly enhances the overall soil structure and improves movement of air and water within the soil, which is essential to healthy plant growth.

SureGrow compost can be purchased at the Waste Management Facility Scale House for \$5.00 per 20 litre bag or in bulk quantities for \$28.00 per tonne. Bulk compost must be self-loaded into a pickup truck or trailer. Additional loader fees apply for all tandem loads.

The Waste Management Facility is currently operating on summer hours:

Monday through Friday - 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
Saturday and Sunday - 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
