### NOTICE TO EMPLOYERS ABOUT VOTING

SUBJECT: MEDICINE HAT MUNICIPAL COUNCIL AND SCHOOL BOARD TRUSTEE ELECTION

The following extract from the Local Authorities Election Act is brought to your attention:

#### HOURS IN WHICH TO VOTE

##### SECTION 58

- (1) An employee who is an elector shall, while the voting stations are open on Election Day, have 3 consecutive hours for the purpose of casting their vote.

#### TIME OFF WORK ALLOWED

- (2) If the hours of the employee's employment do not allow for 3 consecutive hours, the employer shall allow the employee any additional time for voting that is necessary to provide the employee the 3 consecutive hours, but the additional time for voting shall be granted at the convenience of the employer.

*(if the employee's normal employment hours terminate at 5:00 p.m. the employee still have 3 consecutive hours in which to cast their vote)*

- (3) No employer shall make any deduction from the pay of an employee nor impose on the employee or extract from the employee any penalty by reason of the employee's absence from the employee's work during the 3 consecutive hours or part thereof.

- (4) Subsections (1), (2) and (3) do not apply if the employer provides for the attendance of an employee who is an elector at a voting station while it is open during the hours of the employee's employment with no deduction from the employee's pay and without exacting any penalty."

*(if an employer arranges transportation to a voting station during regular working hours, the mandatory 3 consecutive hours in which to vote, does not apply)*

The voting hours on Election Day are 10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

### WATER MAIN FLUSHING & FIRE HYDRANT INSPECTIONS

Environmental Utilities performs regular, routine maintenance to uphold the water quality and system infrastructure by annually flushing water mains and inspecting fire hydrants.

During these operations, there may be some discoloration in the water which is not harmful to consume and will disappear when flushing is complete. Please note that discoloured water should not be used for laundry and that fluctuating water pressure may also be noticed.

Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, turn on your cold water tap or an outside sprinkler and let the water run for several minutes until the water runs clear.
