

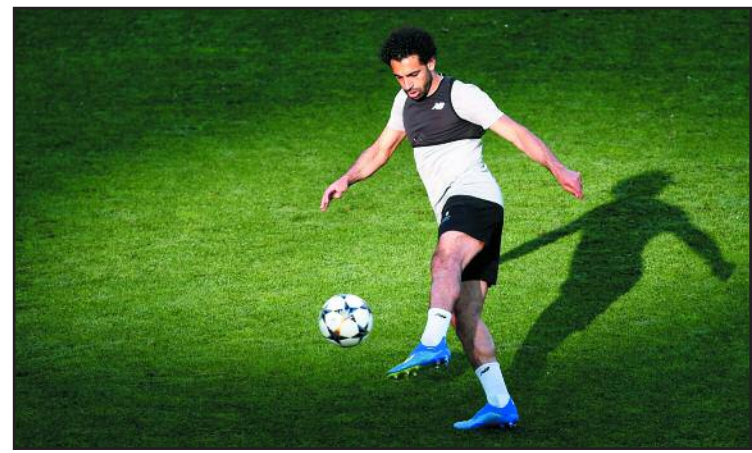
Salah has chance to rise into new stratosphere

KIEV, Ukraine
For once in a Champions League final, Cristiano Ronaldo will yield some of the spotlight to another player sweeping up adulation and personal acclaim. While five-time world player of the year Ronaldo is chasing a record fifth Champions League triumph, and fourth with Real Madrid, Liverpool forward Mohamed Salah is chasing a first. Not just a first Champions League success, but a first major title in football in his maiden cup final. Victory in Kyiv's Olympic

Stadium on Saturday would be a fitting climax to an astonishing debut season at Liverpool for Salah. A season when the Egyptian seized his second chance at a Premier League club with gusto after a faltering spell at Chelsea. Salah has had such a devastating impact that he poses a serious threat to the decade of dominance of the world player of the year award by Ronaldo and Barcelona's Lionel Messi. "Comparing players with Ronaldo and Messi is something you can't do," Real Madrid captain Sergio Ramos said on Friday. "They're in another orbit. There are players who are

in fashion, those who come and go and others who stay around. "Salah is a top player, that's clear. He's shown that this year and he's got a great chance to show that over the next few years as Ronaldo and Messi have done — but the day after tomorrow." While lacking the flashy touch of Ronaldo, and presenting the image of a more modest lifestyle on social media, the "Egyptian King" is as adept at harnessing his commercial appeal. In recent weeks, Salah could be found at news conferences promoting a cellphone company, a logistics firm and taxi service. No wonder Salah is

making the most of his newly-elevated status in the global game. In 2014, when Ronaldo reached the first of his four

Champions League finals with Madrid, Salah was just completing his first five months drifting in and out of the Chelsea team.

WATER MAIN FLUSHING & FIRE HYDRANT INSPECTIONS

Environmental Utilities performs regular, routine maintenance to uphold the water quality and system infrastructure by annually flushing water mains and inspecting fire hydrants.

During these operations, there may be some discoloration in the water which is not harmful to consume and will disappear when flushing is complete. Please note that discoloured water should not be used for laundry and that fluctuating water pressure may also be noticed.

Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, turn on your cold water tap or an outside sprinkler and let the water run for several minutes until the water runs clear.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Watch for your blue cart to be delivered throughout the month of May and into June as the Residential Recycling Program rolls out to your neighbourhood. The Collection Guide handout delivered with your blue recycling cart provides instructions on how to sort and set out your carts.

Once you receive your recycling cart, you may begin to use it immediately. Blue carts will be delivered to the front of your house and will be collected from the same set out location as your grey cart and yard waste cart.

Recycling collection will remain on the same day as your current waste collection day following the same waste zone map and calendar. Please ensure all carts are set out before 7 a.m. with 3 feet clearance between all carts on your designated collection day. PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW #4168 HAMPTONS PHASE 2D

TAKE NOTICE that City Council gave First Reading on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 to Bylaw #4480, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to amend the Land Use Bylaw #4168 to rezone the subject land from Future Urban Development (FUD) to Low Density Residential (R-LD).

The purpose of this Bylaw amendment is to allow the construction of new single detached houses for the future development of 17 residential lots in Phase 2D of the Hamptons neighbourhood.

A Public Hearing in general accordance with the Municipal Government Act and the City's Procedure Bylaw, and consideration of the Second/Third Readings of proposed Bylaw #4480 will be held in the City Hall Council Chambers at the address below on Monday, June 18, 2018, beginning at approximately 6:30 pm. PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW #4168 PORTION OF LOT 1, BLOCK 4, PLAN 1413442 (WITHIN BOX SPRINGS BUSINESS PARK)

TAKE NOTICE that City Council will consider First Reading on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 to Bylaw #4476, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to amend the Land Use Bylaw #4168 to rezone the subject land from Business Industrial (I-B) to Direct Control (DC).

The purpose of this Bylaw amendment is to allow a Development Permit for a Cannabis Production and Distribution Facility to be approved as discretionary use. This rezoning is required because Cannabis Production and Distribution Facility is neither permitted nor discretionary in any land use district in the Land Use Bylaw.
