

Kuznetsov back on ice, could return for Game 2 after big hit

ARLINGTON, Va. Alex Ovechkin predicted Evgeny Kuznetsov would be fine after taking a big hit in the Capitals' 3-2 road victory over the Vegas Golden Knights in Game 2 of the Stanley Cup final.

While his linemate hasn't yet been cleared to play, Washington's captain was onto something.

Kuznetsov took part in an

optional practice Friday morning, two days after getting rocked by Vegas defenceman Brayden McNabb.

The Russian centre, who leads the overall NHL playoff scoring race with 25 points (11 goals, 14 assists), skated off Wednesday night and went straight to the locker-room favouring his left arm after the crushing first-period collision that saw him tumble to the ice along the boards.

The team said at the time he suffered an upper-body injury.

Washington head coach Barry Trotz said Friday that Kuznetsov, who was not made available to the media, will "probably" be a game-time decision when the series shifts to Capital One Arena on Saturday night.

But Ovechkin, one point behind Kuznetsov in the scoring race, reiterated he was confident his regular linemate would be good to go.

"He's one of our top guys," Ovechkin said at Washington's practice facility. "Of course it's

very important to see him skating and I'm pretty sure he's going to be OK (for Game 3)."

The best-of-seven series is tied at one game apiece. Ovechkin, along with defencemen Brooks Orpik, John Carlson and a few other teammates, didn't take part in Friday's on-ice session. But the focus was squarely on Kuznetsov, who didn't seem to be favouring anything as he went through a series of drills with teammates.

"You need everyone at this

time of year," said Tom Wilson, Kuznetsov's other usual winger. "He's a big piece of our team. It's good to see him get out there and feel the puck."

"He looked pretty good." Kuznetsov has been fairly durable throughout his career, something that Trotz has seen first-hand in his four years behind Washington's bench.

The Capitals will host their first Stanley Cup game in 20 years on Saturday. Washington was swept in four games by the Detroit Red Wings in 1998.

WATER MAIN FLUSHING & FIRE HYDRANT INSPECTIONS

Environmental Utilities performs regular, routine maintenance to uphold the water quality and system infrastructure by annually flushing water mains and inspecting fire hydrants.

During these operations, there may be some discoloration in the water which is not harmful to consume and will disappear when flushing is complete. Please note that discoloured water should not be used for laundry and that fluctuating water pressure may also be noticed.

Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, turn on your cold water tap or an outside sprinkler and let the water run for several minutes until the water runs clear.

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Watch for your blue cart to be delivered throughout the month of May and into June as the Residential Recycling Program rolls out to your neighbourhood. The Collection Guide handout delivered with your blue recycling cart provides instructions on how to sort and set out your carts.

Once you receive your recycling cart, you may begin to use it immediately. Blue carts will be delivered to the front of your house and will be collected from the same set out location as your grey cart and yard waste cart.

Recycling collection will remain on the same day as your current waste collection day following the same waste zone map and calendar. Please ensure all carts are set out before 7 a.m. with 3 feet clearance between all carts on your designated collection day. PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW #4168 HAMPTONS PHASE 2D

TAKE NOTICE that City Council gave First Reading on Tuesday, May 22, 2018 to Bylaw #4480, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to amend the Land Use Bylaw #4168 to rezone the subject land from Future Urban Development (FUD) to Low Density Residential (R-LD).

The purpose of this Bylaw amendment is to allow the construction of new single detached houses for the future development of 17 residential lots in Phase 2D of the Hamptons neighbourhood.

A Public Hearing in general accordance with the Municipal Government Act and the City's Procedure Bylaw, and consideration of the Second/Third Readings of proposed Bylaw #4480 will be held in the City Hall Council Chambers at the address below on Monday, June 18, 2018, beginning at approximately 6:30 pm. Any person who claims to be affected by the proposed bylaw may make representation to City Council at the Public Hearing. Oral submissions are limited to five minutes.

A copy of proposed Bylaw #4480 and related documents may be inspected during office hours (8:30 am to 4:30 pm) at Planning & Development Services. Bylaw #4480 may also be accessed via the 'Proposed Bylaws' section on the City's website at www.medicinehat.ca.

Anyone wishing to have a written submission concerning this proposed bylaw placed before the City Council must submit it to: City Clerk Department, 580 First Street SE, Medicine Hat, Alberta T1A 8E6 by 12:00 noon, Wednesday, June 13, 2018.

All submissions are treated as public documents.

2018 PROPERTY TAX NOTICES

The 2018 Property Tax Notices were mailed on May 22, 2018.

TAX DUE DATE

Taxes are due on or before June 30th. Since the due date falls on a Saturday this year, property taxes will be considered paid on time if received at City Hall by 4:30 pm on July 3, 2018 or postmarked by Canada Post on July 3rd.

If a Canada Post postmark is absent or illegible, the date received by the City of Medicine Hat will be considered the payment date. Commercial postage meter imprints will not be honoured.

A penalty of 3.65% will be added to any unpaid balance on July 3, 2018.

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

For a nominal filing fee you can pay half your taxes now, then the rest in monthly installments by signing up for the Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) before June 30, 2018.

HOW TO PAY

The easiest way to pay is by automatic withdrawal through the TIPP payment plan. You can also pay by:

Internet Banking: Payments can be made through telephone/internet banking. Please ensure your taxation account number is registered for telephone/internet banking.

After Hours Drop Box: Payments made by cheque can be deposited in the drop box at the west entrance to City Hall. Please do not leave cash in the drop box.

Post-dated Cheques: Post-dated cheques will be accepted by the City of Medicine Hat. Cheques must be dated for June 30 or earlier.
