



City Council Meeting Highlights November 19, 2018

City Council received for information through Administrative Committee, tender recommendation – GP18-126 Service Rig Services. Service rigs are required for the purpose of oil well optimization, abandonments and/or suspensions, and for possible surface casing vent flow repairs. The tender was awarded to best evaluated bidder meeting specification - Ensign Well Servicing and Spirit West Energy Services in the amount of \$500,000 each.

A recommendation from Development and Infrastructure Committee to change the name of 23 Street NW to Rotary Centennial Drive NW in recognition and celebration of the Rotary's 100th year in 2018 was approved.

City Council received for information through Corporate Services Committee an update on the discontinuation of the current emergency alert service, Notify Me Now. Text messaging alerts and messaging through radio, cable and satellite television can now be accommodated effectively by the Alberta Emergency Alert (AEA) emergency notification system. This will result in annual savings of \$18,500 as the City is able to access the AEA free of charge. Trained City emergency personnel have access to the AEA and can customize messaging to notify residents of local alerts.

Council approved a recommendation through Public Services Committee from the Urban Environment and Recreation Advisory Board for three names to be added to the Sports Wall of Fame. An induction ceremony will be planned at the Family Leisure Centre at a later date to add Dan Federkeil, Eva Pantini-Meyer and Kelly Risling to the Wall.

The meeting minutes of the October 10, 2018 Municipal Planning Commission were received for information.

City Council approved first reading of Bylaw No. 4499, a bylaw to rezone subject land 352 Primrose Drive SE from Open Space (OS) to Medium Density Residential (R-MD). A public hearing will occur at Open Council on December 17, 2018.

City Council approved first reading of Bylaw No. 4502, the Riverside Area Redevelopment Plan bylaw.
