



City Council Meeting Highlights

November 18, 2019

Through Administrative Committee, City Council received Bylaw No. 4601 to amend Bylaw No. 4319, the Emergency Management Bylaw. Amendments to the Emergency Management Bylaw are required in order to comply with the Local Authority Management Regulation which comes into effect on January 1, 2020. The City is already in compliance with the majority of the requirements of the Regulation and Bylaw No. 4601 contains minor amendments (e.g. formalizing the meeting frequency and function of the Emergency Advisory Committee) to ensure complete compliance.

Also through Administrative Committee, Council received Bylaw No. 4602 the Fireworks Bylaw, which will restrict the sale and use of low hazard fireworks and pyrotechnic devices within the City of Medicine Hat in support of community safety. If the Bylaw is enacted by Council, Fire Services will monitor to ensure sales of fireworks are not occurring within the City of Medicine Hat. Fire Services will also issue permits for fireworks or pyrotechnics displays as delegated by the CAO.

City Council approved through Administrative Committee, a request from Economic Development & Land to sell 4979 Southlands Drive SE to Daas Developers Ltd. City Council approved the proposed sale of the property to the purchaser on the general terms and conditions as presented, or as amended, subject to an agreement satisfactory to the Chief Administrative Officer and the City Solicitor.

City Council received for information the October 17, 2019 meeting minutes from the Police Commission.

City Council received for information the August 14, 2019 meeting minutes from the Municipal Planning Commission.

City Council passed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd reading of Bylaw #4601, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to amend Bylaw #4319, the Emergency Management Bylaw, sponsored by Corporate Services Committee.

City Council passed 1st reading of Bylaw #4602, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to regulate and control the sale and discharging of fireworks within the City of Medicine Hat, sponsored by the Public Services Committee.

City Council passed 1st reading of Bylaw #4603, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to adopt the Brier Run Area Structure Plan sponsored by the Municipal Planning Commission. The Brier Run ASP is being proposed to establish a general land use framework to ensure efficient and orderly development that incorporates a range of residential and non-residential uses that will enhance the economy and generate additional property taxes for the City.
