

Jays turn rare triple play

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — Jose Bautista singled home the go-ahead run in the eighth inning and the Toronto Blue Jays turned their first triple play in 33 years Friday night, beating Kansas City 4-3 to hand the slumping Royals their eighth straight defeat.

Kansas City had runners on first and second in the third inning when Eric Hosmer lined out to first baseman Adam Lind, who stepped on the bag to double off Yuniesky Betancourt. Lind then fired to shortstop Yunel Escobar to retire Alex Gordon, who had strayed off second.

It was Toronto's first triple play since Sept. 21, 1979, against the New York Yankees.

Al Cowens was the previous Royals batter to hit into a triple play on June 19, 1979, against Oakland.

Greg Holland (0-2) took the loss while Luis Perez (2-0) worked 1 2-3 scoreless innings to pick up the victory. Sergio Santos got three outs for his second save in four tries.

Contract rules tightened up

NEW YORK — Baseball players and owners have banned the type of personal-services contracts agreed to by Albert Pujols and Ryan Zimmerman during the off-season.

In addition, the sides said Friday they have prohibited the bonuses for milestone accomplishments contained in the deal Pujols signed with the Los Angeles Angels and the agreement between Alex Rodriguez and the New York Yankees that began in 2008.

Only new contracts will be affected under the agreement, reached March 29,

and the previous deals will be allowed to stand.

Pujols' \$240 million, 10-year contract, agreed to in December, says the Angels will offer a personal-services contract for \$1 million annually for 10 years that will start with his retirement and may be declined or terminated by Pujols at any time. The contract also contains a separate marketing agreement in which the Angels agreed to pay up to \$10 million for the promotion and marketing of certain milestone accomplishments — \$3 million for Pujols reaching 3,000 hits and \$7 million for breaking Barry Bonds' record of 762 home runs.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE LAND USE BYLAW #3181

Southlands Phase 6A –
Somerside Way S.E. and Somerside Gate S.E.

TAKE NOTICE that City Council gave First Reading on Monday April 16th, 2012 to Bylaw #4106, a Bylaw of the City of Medicine Hat to amend Bylaw #3181, the Land Use Bylaw.

The land that is the subject of proposed Bylaw #4106, legally described as Lots 1 - 22 inclusive, 24 – 28 inclusive, Block 9, Plan 0912931 (hereinafter referred to as the "subject land") is presently designated as R2-, Low Density Residential District and is the subject to the current R-2 District Overlay Southlands Phase 6 Accessory Dwelling Units in Schedule 'E'.

An application has been made to amend the district overlay of the subject land by modifying Schedule 'E' of the City of Medicine Hat Land Use Bylaw, the R-2 District Overlay Southlands Phase 6 Accessory Dwelling Units;

A Public Hearing in general accordance with the Municipal Government Act and the City's Procedure Bylaw, and consideration of the Second and Third Readings of proposed Bylaw 4106 will be held in Council Chambers at 580 First Street S.E. in Medicine Hat, Alberta on **Tuesday, May 22nd, 2012**, beginning at approximately 6:30 p.m.

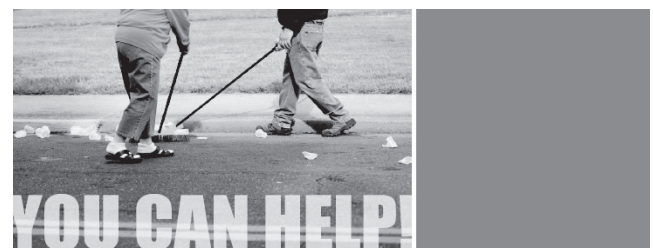
The Solid Waste Utility currently has bags of finished yard waste compost (SureGrow) for sale, while quantities last.
