

Pacers shock Heat in Game 2 of conference finals

MIAMI
David West's right hand helped the Indiana Pacers grab home-court advantage in the Eastern Conference finals. Roy Hibbert scored 29 points, West knocked away two passes by LeBron James for huge turnovers in the final minute, and the Pacers evened the East title series with a 97-93 victory over the Miami Heat in Game 2 of the series on Friday night. Paul George scored 22 points, George Hill added 18 and West finished with 13 for the Pacers, who handed the Heat just their

fourth loss in their last 50 games. The series resumes with Game 3 on Sunday night in Indianapolis. James scored 36 points for the Heat, who got 17 points from Chris Bosh and 14 from Dwyane Wade. The Heat led 88-84 in the fourth quarter, then were outscored 13-5 the rest of the way. And West was the biggest reason. With Indiana up 95-93, West intercepted a pass that James was throwing to Ray Allen with 43 seconds left, but the Pacers didn't even get a shot off on the ensuing

possession. In fact, Indiana may have gotten a bit lucky that the shot clock expired with the ball rolling around — if Wade had collected the ball in time, he had Mario Chalmers all alone at the other end in position to almost certainly tie the game. On the next Miami possession, James drove to the right block, spun and tried passing out toward the perimeter. He released the ball, and West got his right hand on it to knock it off-course. Immediately afterward, West took that same hand and extended it skyward in celebration.

The Pacers — just as they did in the second-round series last year — knew they were winning Game 2 in Miami. Hill made two free throws with 8.3 seconds left to clinch it, and just like that, Miami's home-court advantage was gone. Lance Stephenson scored 10 for the Pacers. The Heat trailed for virtually all of the game's first 30 minutes, then tied the game three times in the third quarter — but Indiana always had a response. When the game was tied at 60, the Pacers scored seven of the next 10 points.

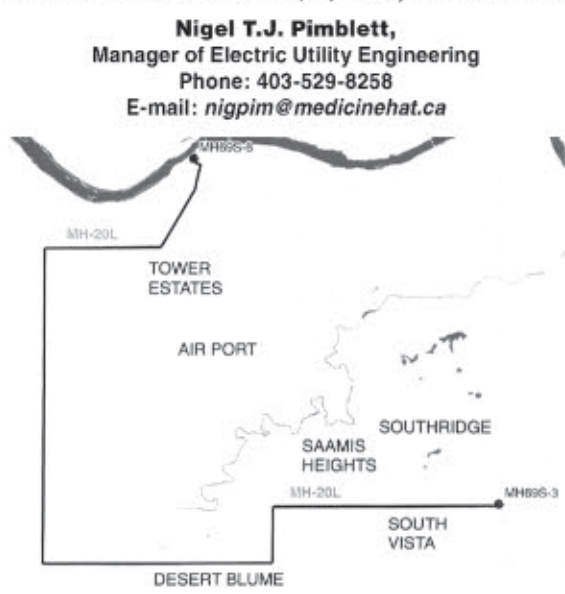
UPGRADE OF THE 69KV TRANSMISSION LINE BETWEEN RIVERVIEW AND SOUTH RIDGE SUBSTATIONS

The City of Medicine Hat is proposing to upgrade a section of 69 kv (kilovolt) transmission line from 69 kv (kilovolt) to 138kv (kilovolt) from its River View Substation MH69S-6 to its South Ridge Substation MH69S-3. The 20L transmission line upgrade will help meet the growing electrical demand in the South Ridge area enabling the City to continue providing reliable electric service to the area.

Refer to the photo below, for the proposed routing for the new transmission line. The proposed work is scheduled to take place in the later part of 2013 completing in the summer of 2014, depending on approvals from the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC). The construction and installation should be completed within approximately seven months and no service interruptions are anticipated.

During the transmission line upgrade, there will be large equipment on site including flat-deck semitrailer, cranes, bucket trucks and digger trucks. The City will work to minimize noise, dust or other disturbances to residents as a result of this work.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NEW LAND USE BYLAW

On Tuesday, May 21st, 2013 the Medicine Hat City Council gave first reading to Bylaw #4168 -- a new Land Use Bylaw for the City.

The Land Use Bylaw is the key piece of municipal legislation prescribing the **uses** that can lawfully be made of lands in various parts of the City, and the **regulations** governing the manner in which those uses must be carried out.

THEREFORE TAKE NOTICE that a **Public Hearing** on the proposed new Land Use Bylaw, in accordance with the Municipal Government Act and Procedure Bylaw #2270, will be held before the City Council in the City Hall Council Chambers, at 580 First Street S.E. in Medicine Hat, Alberta on **Monday, June 17th, 2013**, beginning at approximately 6:30 p.m. Following the Public Hearing, the Council may choose to proceed with second reading of the bylaw at that same meeting. If second reading is passed, the Council may then choose to proceed to third and final reading of the bylaw at that time.

Any person who claims to be affected by the proposed bylaw may make verbal representation to the City Council at the Public Hearing. It is not necessary to give advance notice of a verbal submission, but it is limited to five minutes in duration.

Any person wishing to have a **written submission** concerning this proposed bylaw placed before the City Council **must submit it to the City Clerk Department by 12:00 o'clock noon, Wednesday June 12th, 2013**. The mailing address is 580 First Street S.E., Medicine Hat, Alberta, T1A 8E6. The e-mail address is clerk@medicinehat.ca. Any such written submission will become a public document.

A copy of proposed Bylaw #4168 and related documents may be inspected during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) at the City Clerk Department, Second Floor, City Hall, 580 First Street S.E., Medicine Hat, Alberta. The Bylaw itself, not including related documents, may be accessed via the Internet under the 'Proposed Bylaw' section on the City's website at www.medicinehat.ca.

The **Municipal Government Act** does not allow for the filing of a petition to put this bylaw to a general vote of the electors.

GAS DISTRIBUTION 1ST STREET SE PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Overview:
The project involves replacing a gas main to ensure the continued safe and reliable delivery of natural gas in Medicine Hat. This project is scheduled to start on June 3, 2013 and will take approximately 6 weeks dependent on the weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Road Closures throughout the Project:

- A portion of 1st Street SE between 6th Avenue and South Railway Street SE will be closed to through traffic for approximately two weeks.
- Maple Avenue south bound will be closed to one lane for portions of this project.
- The laneway behind Tim Horton's on Maple Avenue will be closed for approximately two weeks.
- Please use alternate routes and avoid walking through the construction site.

For your safety and that of the workers please obey all posted signs and detours.

General Information:
Riverside Memorial Park will have limited access during the Pipeline Replacement Project.
The Gas Lamps within Riverside Memorial Park will be disconnected during this project and will be converted to LED during the Downtown Gas Lamp Conversion Program.

FIRE HYDRANT & WATER MAIN FLUSHING

The Environmental Utilities Department will test and flush fire hydrants plus water mains until October 2013. This is an annual maintenance activity that maintains water quality and system infrastructure. Residents may notice some discoloring of water, which is not harmful and will disappear when flushing is complete. Fluctuating pressure may also be noticed. Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, you may wish to flush the water from your home for a few minutes by watering your lawn or running your tap.
