

Shave tourney grows

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The Barrie Shave Memorial Classic Doubles Tournament just keeps growing and growing.

The 15th edition of this annual men's and women's doubles tennis tourney started on Friday at the Crestwood Courts.

Action is expected to run from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and 9 a.m. to about 4 p.m. on Sunday.

"It has gotten bigger and bigger," said Ken Clement, who is the manager of the Medicine Hat Tennis Club.

"This year we have 46 teams, which is 92 people playing. That is a testimony I think to the fact that people want to participate in an event like this and also that tennis is growing thanks to the efforts of the tennis club."

The tournament started in 1999, when Medicine Hat Tennis Club member and regular doubles player Barrie Shave was battling pancreatic cancer. Shave played in the first event.

"It originally started as a fundraising tournament to support fighting cancer," said Clement. "He passed away about six weeks after the tournament ended."

"Since then, it has been a memorial tournament. The purpose of the tournament is to encourage participation. This is not a tournament that is limited to high-end players by any means."

"We want everybody to participate. Our other purpose is to fundraise for cancer research and also for our tennis junior program."

Last year, the Barrie Shave tournament raised \$7,500 to support cancer research and the junior program.

Clement said the club would like to see similar success on the fundraising front this year.

The tournament has attracted players from Calgary and Lethbridge and also a former club member from Sherbrooke, Que.

Clement said the participation keeps the Medicine Hat Tennis Club's facility, which has seven courts, jumping.

"Having seven courts and having them all so nicely designed has meant that we can basically run a big event like this in one location," said Clement. "In the old days, you used to have to send people all over town to play."

"If the tournament gets much bigger, we will probably have to start doing that again. It is a nice problem to have."

U.S. Open course beats up players

ARDMORE, Pa. Phil Mickelson made his first birdie on his last putt. Billy Horschel never missed a green. It was all they could do to barely break par against Merion, which is turning out to be the real star of this U.S. Open.

Nearly half the field did not finish the second round when it was suspended by darkness. Moments after the horn sounded to stop play, Mickelson opted to finish his round and drilled a 20-foot birdie putt for a 2-over 72. That gave him a share of the clubhouse lead with Horschel, who made it as easy as possible by hitting every green in regulation for a 67.

They were at 1-under 139. Even with the round not finished, it was becoming clear that this U.S. Open might be up for grabs until the very end. Tiger Woods, who grimaced with every shot out of the rough because of pain in his left elbow, was at 3-over 143 and still very much in the game.

"I don't know how anyone is going to separate too far from the field," Mickelson said. "There might be a hot round tomorrow."
