FIRE HYDRANT & WATER MAIN FLUSHING

The Environmental Utilities Department will test and flush fire hydrants plus water mains until October 2013. This is an annual maintenance activity that maintains water quality and system infrastructure. Residents may notice some discoloring of water, which is not harmful and will disappear when flushing is complete. Fluctuating pressure may also be noticed. Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, you may wish to flush the water from your home for a few minutes by watering your lawn or running your tap. Please note that the flushing in your home will not correct private plumbing/corrosion problems. Thank you for your understanding.

The City of Medicine Hat & Cypress County would like to say **Thank You and Congratulations to all of the 2013 Southern Alberta Summer Games Participants and Volunteers**



The City of Medicine Hat finished 3rd in the overall points standings behind the MD of Taber and the City of Lethbridge. Medicine Hat athletes won a total of 59 Gold medals 33 Silver medals and 28 Bronze medals for a grand total of 120 medals.

Cypress County finished in 5th place at this year's games and also had 120 medals with 44 Gold medals, 38 Silver medals and 38 Bronze medals.

The Medicine Hat team also grew in participation with over 355 athletes and coaches attending the 44th annual games in Taber with Cypress sending an equally impressive 139 athlete's. With next year's games being held in Pincher Creek we hope to see many faces again at next year's games.

SureGrow is a class A compost that greatly enhances overall soil structure and improves movement of air and water within the soil - essential to healthy plant growth. Plants grown in soil amended with compost tend to be healthier, require less watering and are more disease and pest resistant.

Bagged compost can be purchased for \$5.00 per 20 kg bag at the Landfill Scale House, during summer hours, which are:

8 am to 5 pm, Saturday and Sunday
