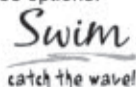
ROLLING registration is HERE! We will be posting classes on a continuous basis to increase access and decrease hassle. Improved access to registration will mean no more panicked registration days!

The Solid Waste Utility currently has bags of finished yard waste compost (SureGrow) for sale, while quantities last.

SureGrow is a class A compost that greatly enhances overall soil structure and improves movement of air and water within the soil - essential to healthy plant growth. Plants grown in soil amended with compost tend to be healthier, require less watering and are more disease and pest resistant.

Bagged compost can be purchased for \$5.00 per 20 kg bag at the Landfill Scale House, during summer hours, which are:

FIRE HYDRANT & WATER MAIN FLUSHING

The Environmental Utilities Department will test and flush fire hydrants plus water mains until October 2013. This is an annual maintenance activity that maintains water quality and system infrastructure. Residents may notice some discoloring of water, which is not harmful and will disappear when flushing is complete. Fluctuating pressure may also be noticed. Should discoloration persist beyond three hours, you may wish to flush the water from your home for a few minutes by watering your lawn or running your tap. Please note that the flushing in your home will not correct private plumbing/corrosion problems. Thank you for your understanding.

MEDICINE HAT TRANSMISSION UPGRADE PROJECT MH-10L

The City of Medicine Hat is proposing an upgrade to one of its electricity transmission lines. The project would consist of three parts:

- 1) Addition of a 138/69 kV transformer within the fenced area of the existing North Industrial substation, located at 1480 52nd Street NW.
- 2) Construction of a new substation, to be designated as MHS-8, in an area just west of the TransCanada Highway, on the north side of the South Saskatchewan River. This substation will consist of a single 138/69 kV transformer, with one transmission line entering from the south, and one from the north.
- 3) Upgrade the existing MH-10L transmission line from the North Industrial substation to substation MHS-8 from 69 kV to 138 kV. The structures will be of wood pole construction, similar to what currently exists.

Due to increased demand for electricity within the City, the existing 69 kV facilities are near capacity, and upgrading the line will enable the City to continue providing reliable electrical service to the area for years to come. The proposed work would take place in 2014 and 2015. The work will not cause any interruptions to electric service in the area. During the upgrade, there would be large equipment on site including pole trailers, utility bucket trucks and digger trucks. Work would take place during the day and the City will work to minimize noise, dust, lights, or other disturbances.



Details of proposed upgrade:

The transmission line connects the two substations as shown in the enclosed diagrams. The upgrade would increase the line from its current 69,000 volts (69 kV) to 138,000 volts (138 kV). The line will employ the same route currently used.

Public consultation:

We will use stakeholder feedback to help us refine the project. We anticipate filing an application for the project with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) in the fall of 2013. Subject to regulatory approval, construction would take place in 2014 and 2015.
