

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

City of Medicine Hat hereby gives notice that a (Owner – Individual or company name)

submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 4(1) of the said Act,

City of Medicine Hat has deposited a notification of a minor work (Owner – individual or company name)

in accordance with the requirements set out on the External Submission Site, on the online Common Project Search Registry (http://cps.canada.ca/) and

under registry number 6156, a description of the following work:

Aerial Cable to 2001, 5431 TWP Rd 132A Rd S (nature and status of work – e.g., existing/proposed erosion-protection works, aerial cables, submarine cables, buried pipelines, outfalls and water intakes, dredging, watercourse crossings, etc.) – not merely "minor works" or such general terms)

in, on, over, under, through or

across South Saskatchewan River (name of the river, the lake or other navigable water)

at Medicine Hat (name of place where minor work is to be located)

in front of lot number 2001 5431 TWP Rd 132A R S (or at the foot of such a street, etc.) (see note below)

Posted at Medicine Hat, AB this 25 day of July, 2022 (City, Province) (day) (Month) (year) (full name of owner)

NOTE: It is essential that the location of the existing or proposed minor work be properly identified for the information of the public. The location of the work may also be indicated as being on a water lot, giving the number of the water lot or lot number in front of which it is situated. Where a work is to extend from one side of the river to the other, as in the case of submarine or aerial cables, pipelines, etc., the location should read from to (Well-specified points)
