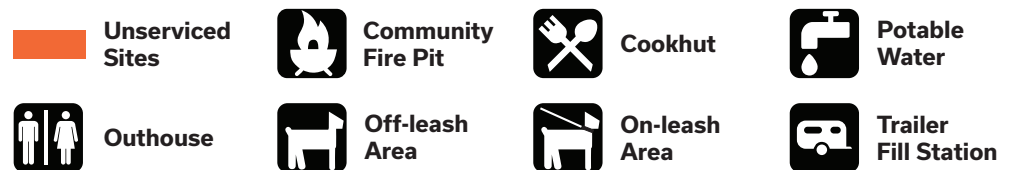
- Swimming Lake open daily 11:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Each unserviced site includes a gravel pad, fire pit and picnic table. Camping essentials, including firewood, are available at the Swim Centre concession.

DURING YOUR STAY

- Park Main Gate closed from 11:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m.
If you need to enter or leave the park during this time, there is a combination lock that can be used to unlock the gate. If you need staff assistance during this time, please call our non-emergency line at (403) 526-2828.
- Please respect quiet time from 11:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m.
- Visitors are permitted until 10:30 p.m.
- Community camp kitchen, fire pit and wood sales on-site
- Pit washrooms on site
- Flush toilets & showers available at the Swim Centre from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.
- Ensure pets are leashed, not left unattended, and that you tidy up after them
- Vehicles must remain on roadways and parking pads; please do not drive or park on the grass
- Garbage receptacles are located throughout the campground for your convenience
- Dump stations available at Gas City Campground and the Tourist Information Centre
- Echo Dale Campground is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Do not approach or feed the wildlife

FIRE PIT USAGE

- Please confine fires to the fire pits provided
- Keep your campsite and fire pit clean at all times
- Please use clean or commercially sold firewood only, no Elm wood
- Pallets, wood pieces with nails, metal etc. are not permitted

BE A GOOD NEIGHBOUR

We want everyone to experience the sunshine, peace of the coulees, rolling prairies and more during their stay. Please be courteous to your neighbours and avoid excessive noise from music or generators and late-night partying.



ALCOHOL

In accordance with the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Act, alcohol consumption is restricted to registered campsites and is not permitted anywhere other than in designated campsites.

TOBACCO OR CANNABIS

In accordance with Bylaw No. 4136, Smoke Free Outdoor Public Places Bylaw, smoking is prohibited around other outdoor public places which include playgrounds, kitchen shelters, administration buildings, washrooms and campground visitor parking areas. Cigarettes, cigars, vaping and cannabis should be treated like alcohol and only consumed in your designated campsite.

Please remember to pay attention to your surroundings when consuming cannabis, tobacco products or alcoholic beverages. Be aware and respectful towards others.
