

Hewitt & Black Warehouse

In 1910, J.J. Hewitt purchased Lot 36-37 from Mrs. M.B. Redpath, per City of Medicine Hat property tax records. No building permit was found but tax records indicate J.J. Hewitt paid taxes on the property from 1910 on. Hewitt and Black operated a retail outlet at #656 -2 St. "wholesale & retail hardware, tinsmiths, and plumbers". According to the historical survey, the warehouse remained under the Hewitt & Black name until 1950.
