 <p>Aluminum & Tin Cans</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Metal food cans • Aluminum pie plates and trays • NO aerosol or paint cans • NO aluminum pots, frying pans or other metal items 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove labels • Rinse clean • Pinch ends closed
 <p>Beverage Containers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pop bottles and cans • Water bottles • Alcoholic beverage cans and bottles • Milk jugs and cartons • Juice containers and cartons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return at either Bottle Depot located within the city to receive your deposit on the container back!
 <p>Glass Bottles & Jars</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean, clear bottles • Glass jars • NO pyrex dishes, light bulbs, window or auto glass 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse clean • Remove lids and labels • Avoid breaking glass
 <p>Plastic Containers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All types of clean household plastic • Plastic shopping bags • NO motor oil or chemical containers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rinse containers • Flatten containers to conserve space

	Newspapers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newspaper All newspaper inserts that arrive in your mailbox NO plastic bags NO tied bundles 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clean, dry material only Leave newspapers loose DO NOT include any non-newsprint material or products
	Mixed Paper <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clean, dry cardboard; boxboard; office paper; envelopes; junk mail; magazines; catalogues NO soiled paper or non-recyclable items including pizza boxes, paper plates, styrofoam and books 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Flatten boxes and break down cardboard to conserve space Remove any plastic liners from boxes Shredded paper is accepted in <u>clear</u> plastic bags
