Who is an Energy Advisor?

Energy advisors, using the EnerGuide Rating System (ERS), work with a service organization to assess the energy performance and potential energy savings for homes. They will provide advice to homeowners, and can also work with builders who want to improve energy efficiency of their homes.

Service organizations and energy advisors can assist residents in Medicine Hat as they apply for HAT Smart's EnerGuide Ratings for New Homes Incentive Program and Air Sealing Incentive Program. They can also help residents obtain an EnerGuide rating and label for their home. Please work with the service provider to ensure that they are qualified to complete the work under the program for which you are interested in applying.

Energy Advisors

Who is an energy advisor?

Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) licenses service providers across Canada to deliver its EnerGuide Rating System, ENERGY STAR® for New Homes and R-2000 initiatives promoting energy-efficient homes. You can contact a service provider in your area to learn about services and programs available to you.

Energy advisors work with the licensed service organizations and complete mandatory training and examination to obtain certification through NRCan. They assess the energy performance and potential energy savings for homes. They can also provide assistance during the design, construction, and renovation stage. Energy advisors will provide advice to homeowners, and can also work with builders who want to improve energy efficiency of their homes.

Why do I need to contact an energy advisor?

You'll need to contact an energy advisor if you are interested in applying for the following programs:

EnerGuide Ratings for New Homes Incentive Program—an energy advisor will help you obtain your home's EnerGuide rating throughout the construction process. This rating must be obtained under the ERS V.15 rating system to qualify.

Air Sealing Incentive Program—to qualify for a rebate, you'll need to have a blower door test completed by an energy advisor before and after the air sealing work is completed to measure the percent reduction in air infiltration. This calculation will be used to determine your rebate amount.

Can I work with an energy advisor that does not appear on this list?

Yes, as long as the energy advisor has completed the proper examination and is registered through Natural Resources Canada. This list is for reference purposes only and is offered to assist residents in finding local service providers.
