

INDUCTION PROCESS

1. Nominee or team prepares and submits an application.
2. A citizen may nominate an individual or team and complete the application on their behalf.
3. Applications are reviewed and recommended by the Urban Environment and Recreation Advisory Board to City Council.
4. A public reception and plaque unveiling will be hosted by the City of Medicine Hat once per year, subject to nominations received and approval of recipients.
5. A permanent plaque will be installed on the Sports Wall of Fame at the Family Leisure Centre.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- To recognize community leaders in sports (outstanding success or contributions).
- To honour sports related individuals and teams of the past and inspire those of the future.
- To honour significant human contributions to sports while representing Medicine Hat.
- To display the history of sports in Medicine Hat.
- To instill a Medicine Hat identity and show pride in outstanding sports achievements.



SELECTION COMMITTEE

- The Urban Environment and Recreation Advisory Board will act as the Sports Wall of Fame Committee.
- The Committee will review applications received and weigh against applicable criteria.
- The Committee will vote on applications to be sent to City Council for final approval.



SELECTION CRITERIA

- Significant local, provincial, national or international recognition.
- Sustained ambassadorship of Medicine Hat in sports.
- Longevity of achievement in sports.
- Contribution towards the betterment of the sports community.
- Born or moved to the Medicine Hat area (within last 10 years), and considers the Medicine Hat area an important part of their life experience.
- Excelled in sports as a leader (athlete, builder, administrator, official, media broadcaster, sports writer, team, sponsor, etc.)
- Minimum of 10 years of experience in their field.
- Outstanding/extraordinary success.
- Athletes must be in retirement from competition, but can still be active in the sport in other ways.
- Nominees are eligible for three selection years only, and then removed from the selection process unless their accomplishments change.



COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

1. Application form available online at www.medicinehat.ca/walloffame, or can be picked up at the Parks & Recreation office.
2. Describe all local, provincial, national and/or international sports recognitions that apply. Include newspaper or magazine articles if available.
4. Include at least two letters of support, and 5x7 or larger photo of nominee with the signed application form.
5. Incomplete applications will be returned.
6. Email or hand deliver completed application to the address provided on the back of this brochure.
