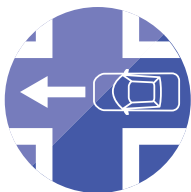


Intersection Safety

7 tips about intersections to improve safety in your community.



1. At uncontrolled intersections, the motorist of the vehicle to the left must yield to the motorist on the right.



2. At a stop controlled intersection or red light, motorists must come to a complete stop.



3. Always watch for pedestrians at intersections, pedestrians have the right of way.

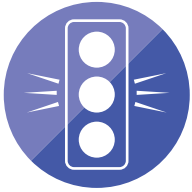


4. Keep an eye open for signage permitting or prohibiting certain movements.





5. U-turns are not permitted at intersections controlled by a traffic control signal or where prohibited by a sign.



6. Do not speed up to make it through a yellow light.



7. Slow down and use caution when entering an intersection.

Why are these rules important to follow?

Intersections have the highest chance of conflict in our roadway network.

Being cautious and aware when entering an intersecting greatly reduces this chance.

Violations are enforceable under **Medicine Hat Public Roads Bylaw No. 4346** and the Alberta Traffic Safety Act.
