

## Parking

### 5 parking tips to improve safety in your community.

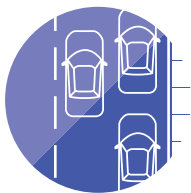


1. Do not park within:

- **5 m** of a crosswalk, fire hydrant, stop sign or yield sign.
- **1.5 m** of a driveway
- A marked **bus zone**.



2. Look for and adhere to signage indicating parking restrictions.



3. Do not double park.



4. Leave early to ensure you have time to find a parking space.



5. Consider parking farther away and walking to your location!

# Why are these rules important to follow?

Parking in “no parking” areas:

- Reduces visibility of pedestrians.
- Increases the chance of a conflict between vehicles and pedestrians.
- Is against the law and you could be ticketed.

and the Alberta Traffic Safety Act.
