



# 2009 Census Coordinator and Team Leader's Report

# INTRODUCTION

The City of Medicine Hat's 2009 Census was conducted from June 1 to 30, 2009.

The population of Medicine Hat continues to increase.

The new population figure is 61,097 or 671 persons or 1.1%.

The main benefits of conducting a 2009 census are:



A significant annual increase in per capita grants (estimated to be in the \$300,000 range) and



Important/detailed demographic information for a wide variety of analysis/study

All of the tests we performed confirms that the population figure is likely accurate within 1% to 2%.

# **ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS**

The Project Team was composed of 35 census takers, the Information and Computer Services Department, Mail/Print Room, Transit (the digital advertising on the buses was seen by many/many residents), Business Development Officer and the entire City Clerk Department, as well as Saamis Immigration Services Association.

Every census brings its own set of challenges and this year, they ranged from weather, replacing census takers due to illness, to repeat call backs. In addition, the  $\pm$  1,355 unoccupied dwelling residents was reflected by the June, 2009 rental vacancy rate of 4.8% and the dramatic drop in house starts.

Once again, thousands of residents cooperated and mailed, delivered, phoned or sent call back information by e-mail or facsimile transmission (fax). We thank them and look forward to providing an on line service capability for the next census. The new call back form worked very well.



# West Crescent Heights

 The population has been relatively the same for many years.

# East Crescent Heights

• increased by 429 persons that reflects the continued development north of 20<sup>th</sup> Street (Northlands) and the Ranchlands Subdivision.

River Heights/Harlow/South East and West Hill, Kensington/Downtown and Flats

 the drop of 571 is likely due to the increased vacancies.

# Ross Glen/Taylor

• it was noted, this area had little change in 2008 and 2009 after the drop in 2005.

# South Ridge/South Vista Heights/Saamis Heights

• this part of the city continues to be the other growth area with an increase of 840 persons. . . . with more to come when construction increases.

Note: East Crescent Heights and South of the Trans Canada Highway now total 41% of the population count.




