BY-LAW NO: 2498

A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF MEDICINE HAT to regulate the use or operation of alternately flashing red lights and stop arms on school buses within the City of Medicine Hat.

WHEREAS a recent amendment to the Highway Traffic Act R.S.A., 1980, c. H-7, as amended, requires the operator of a school bus to activate the alternately flashing red lights and the stop arm on a school bus when he is stopped on a highway for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers;

AND WHEREAS the said amendment contains a subsection whereby the council of a municipality may, by-law, regulate the time during which the locations at which or the circumstances under which, as the case may be, the alternately flashing red lights and stop arm on a school bus may be, shall be or shall not be used while the school bus is operating on a highway under the control of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Medicine Hat considers it advisable to adopt such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MEDICINE HAT, IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This by-law may be cited as the School Bus Alternately Flashing Red Lights and Stop Arm By-Law.

- 2. The Operator of a school bus shall not use or activate, while the school bus is operating, the alternately flashing red lights or the stop arm on a school bus on any highway within the limits of the City of Medicine Hat.
- 3. This by-law shall take effect on the 1st day of December, A.D., 1986.
