CONSOLIDATION OF A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF MEDICINE HAT TO authorize the levying of a charge for dishonoured payments.

- 1. In this Bylaw,
 - (a) "Chief Administrative Officer" means the City's chief administrative officer appointed pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, S.A 1994, Chapter M-26.1;
 - (b) "City" means the City of Medicine Hat;

Amended by: Bylaw 3671 Jan. 24, 2006 (c) "dishonoured payment" means a cheque or electronic funds payment that is not honoured by the bank or other financial institution processing the cheque or electronic funds payment;

Amended by: Bylaw 4372 Oct. 18, 2016 (d) "invalid account" means a payment that has been submitted to an account that does not actively exist requiring intervention to find and transfer the payment to the correct account.
